Some interesting facts about our Queen



Queen Elizabeth starts her day with a cup of tea – Earl Grey specifically — with no added sugar or milk. The Queen chooses between three breakfast choices on any given day: cereal with fresh fruit, toast with marmalade, or scrambled eggs with smoked salmon and a grating of truffle.

Each day at 5 p.m. precisely, the Queen indulges in high tea, where she treats herself to a full afternoon spread of scones and finger sandwiches. (cucumber) According to her former butler, the Queen used to toss the scones under the table for her corgis to feast on. Her rules for finger sandwiches: no crusts and never cut rectangularly lest they resemble coffins and bring her bad luck.

Would you like to eat like the Queen?

You could try preparing cucumber sandwiches with cream cheese and remember not to cut the sandwiches in a rectangular shape.
